What are Marketplace Collections?

Collections are designed to enhance how users discover, organize, and share content across Marketplace.

Collections allow logged-in users to curate and share groups of Datasets, Solutions, and Blueprints tiles with both logged-in and external audiences, making it easier to organize relevant offerings by use case or specific need, in a single, streamlined experience.

Key Features of Collections

- **Create Collections:** Easily create a Collection from any Dataset, Solution, or Blueprint tile. Add or remove offerings and organize them into new or existing Collections.
- **Update Collection Details:** Manage Collections from the [Global Search Catalog page](#). Update the name, description, and offerings included in the Collection.
- **Share Collections:** Use the 'Copy Shareable Link' feature to share the Collection you created with internal or external users – no login required.
- **Save Collections to Your Account:** Recipients of a shared Collection can log-in to 'Save to My Collections', to copy the Collection into their own account, allowing them to customize it without affecting the original.

Use Cases and Best Practices

Use Cases

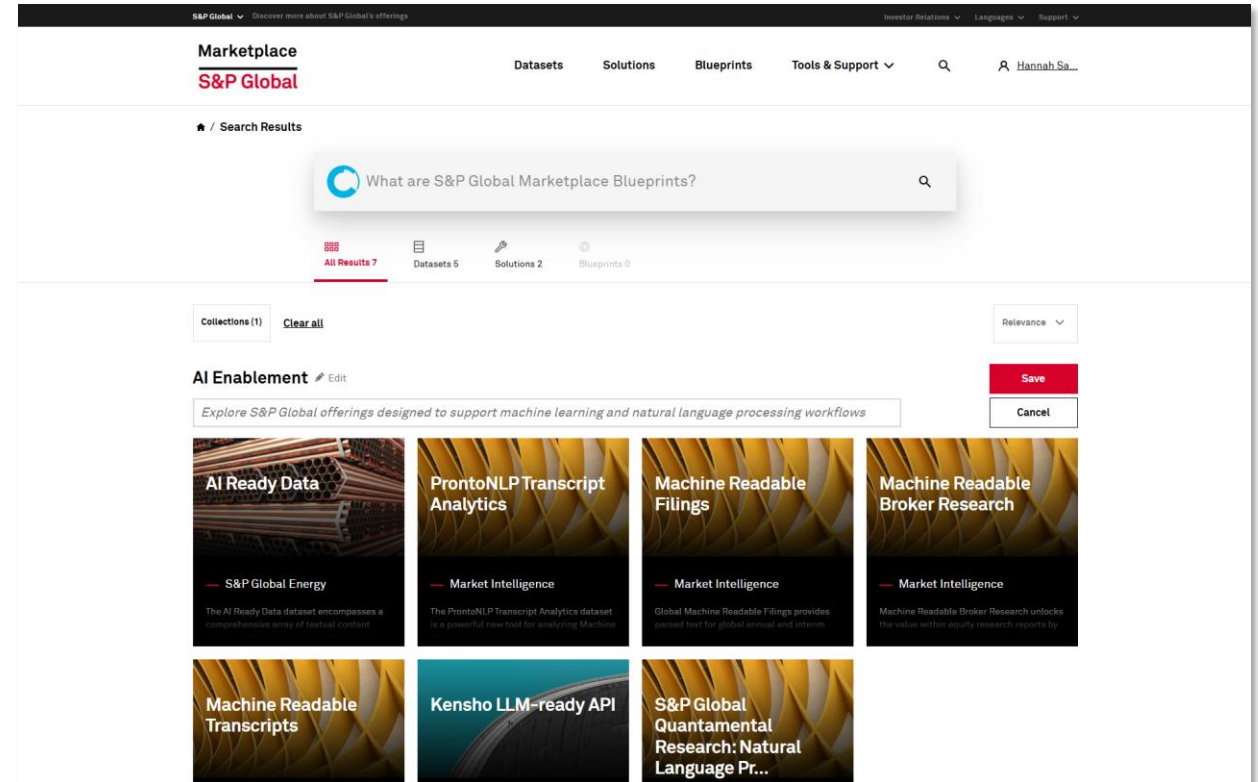
- **External Users:** Quickly add S&P Global offerings to Collections for future reference or evaluation. Curate and share tailored sets of offerings with colleagues, eliminating the need to send multiple URLs via email.
- **Internal Users:** Easily assemble Collections of S&P Global offerings before, during, or after client meetings. Curate and share Collections aligned to specific use cases (e.g., S&P Global Data Starter Kit) or business units (e.g., Data & Research Offerings) for internal and client-facing use.

Best Practices

- **Avoid sharing Collections on public forums.** Anyone with the link (including external audiences) can view Collection details. Collections are designed to facilitate peer-to-peer sharing, not external-facing content.
- **Be mindful of what you include.** While Collections are private when first created, names, descriptions and included offerings become visible to other users once shared.
- **Keep shared Collections up to date.** Other users may rely on your Collections over time. Remove outdated content or delete unused Collections and notify anyone you've shared them with.

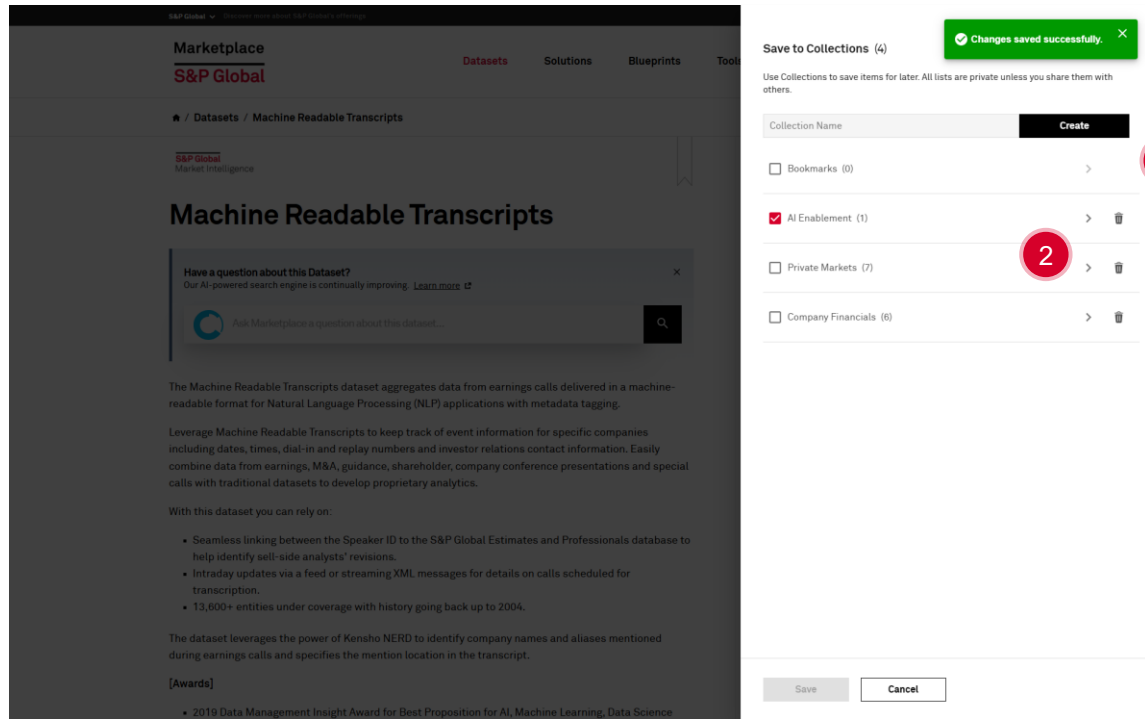

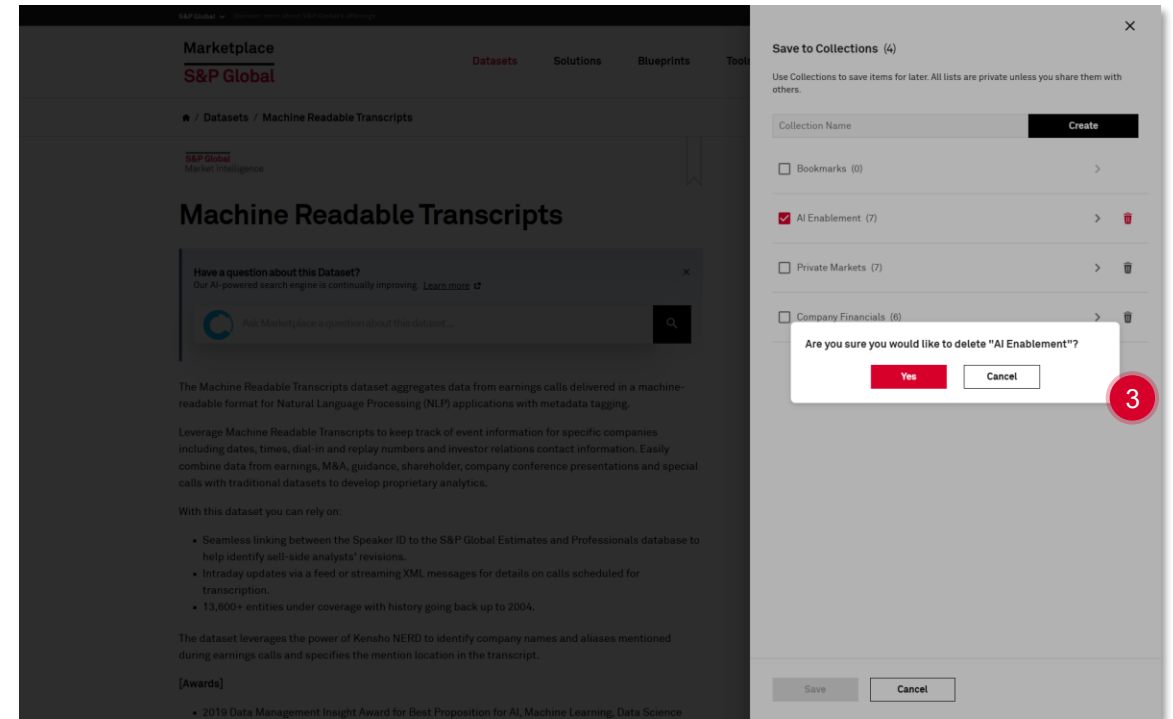
Sample Collection in Edit Mode

Creating and Managing Collections



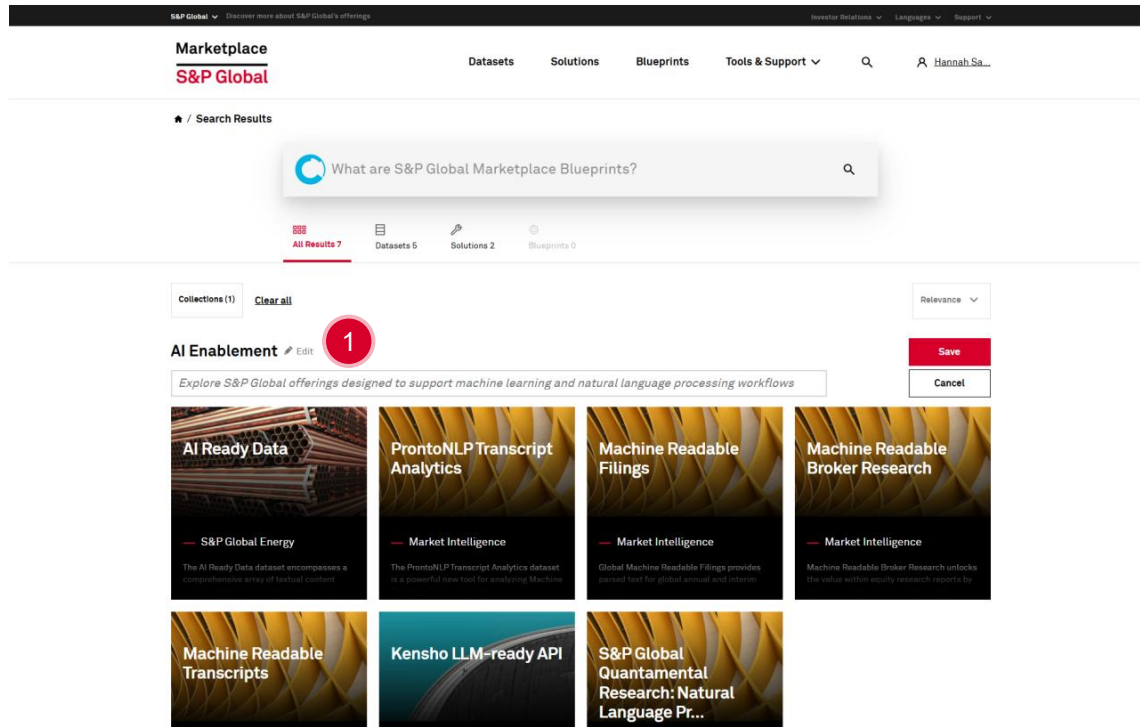
1 Selecting the 'Save to Collection' button will open the Collections side panel, where you can create new Collections and add/remove from an existing Collection.

2 Users can also view the contents of a Collection by selecting the arrow icon.

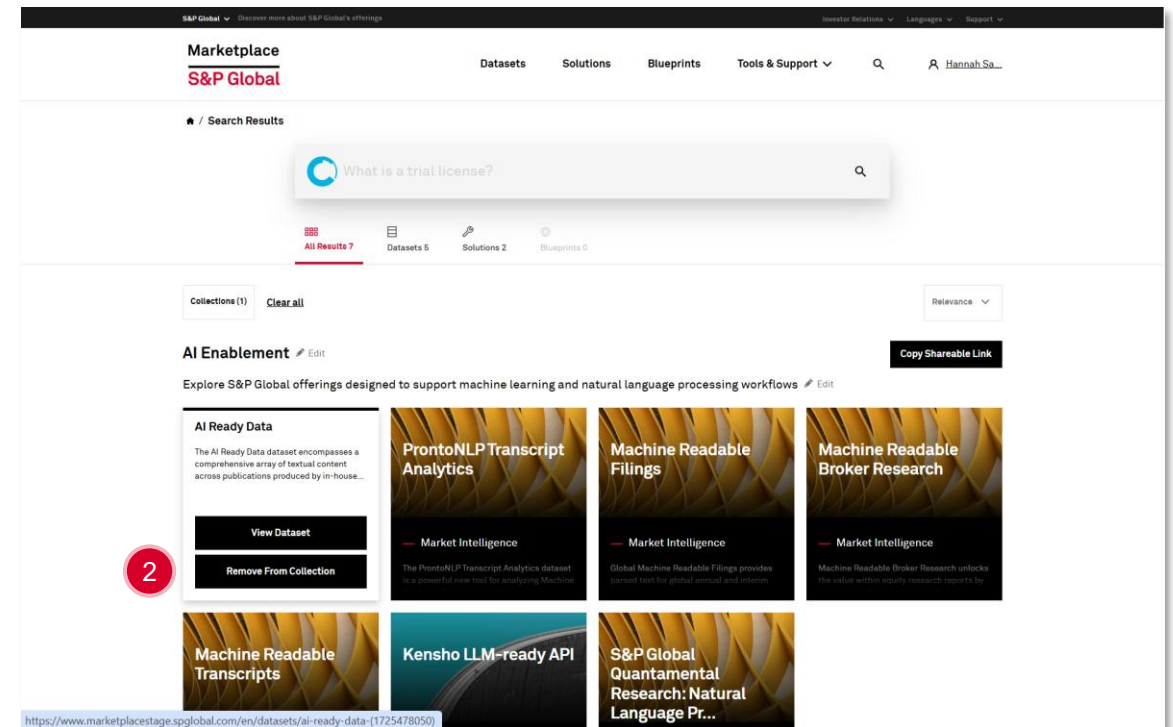


3 Users can also delete Collections by selecting the trash icon.

Viewing Collections and Editing Collection Details

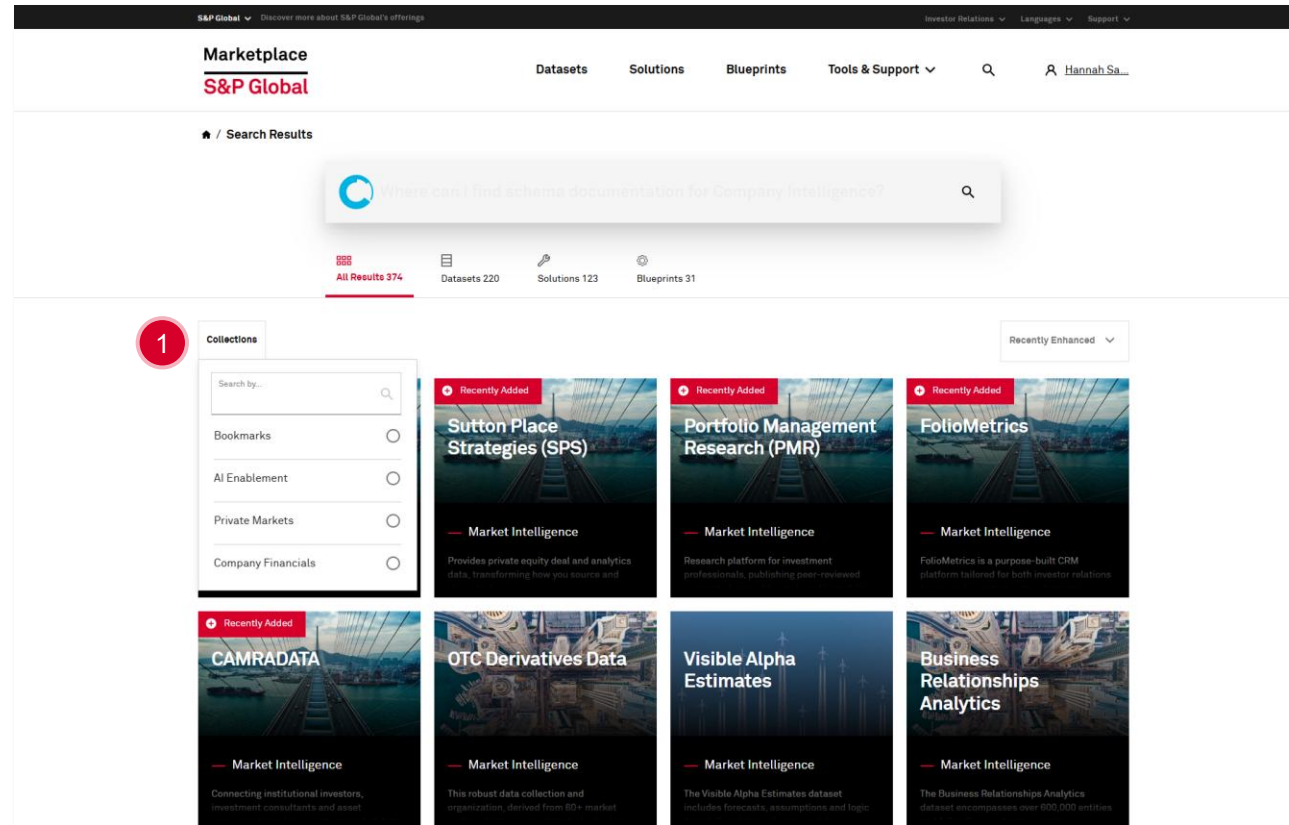


1 Selecting the arrow icon from the Collections panel will allow users to view all offerings in the selected Collection. Users can also edit the Collection and description by selecting the 'Edit' icons.



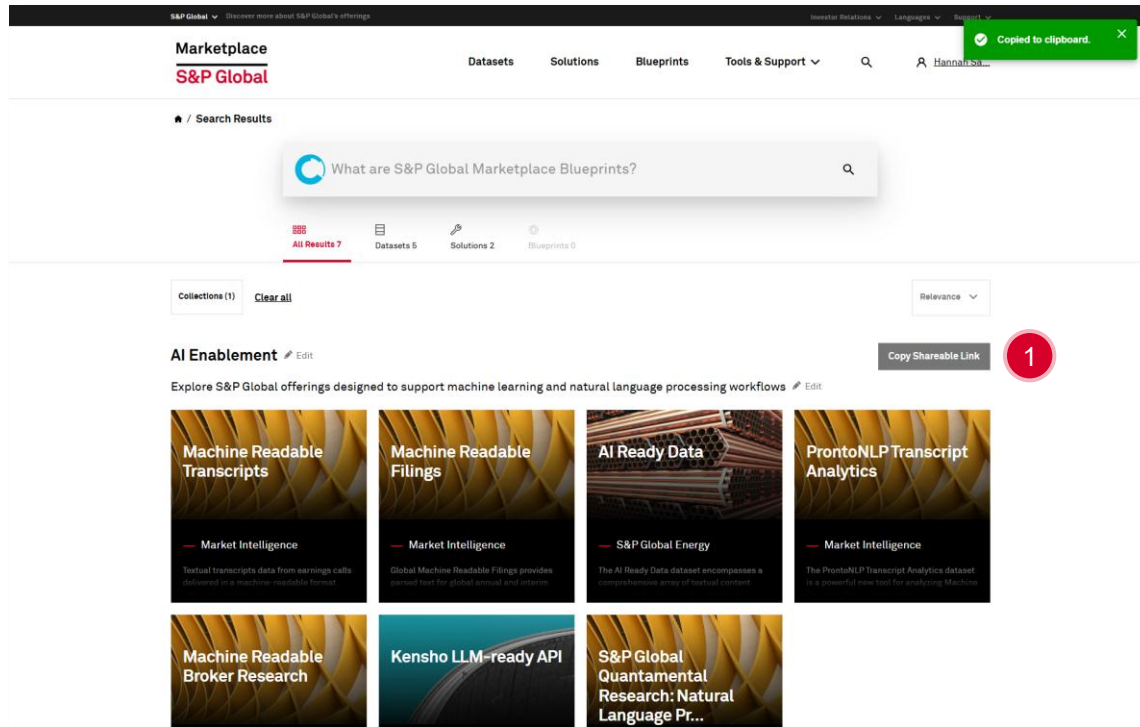
2 Remove offerings by hovering over a tile and select 'Remove from Collection'.

Viewing Collections from Global Search

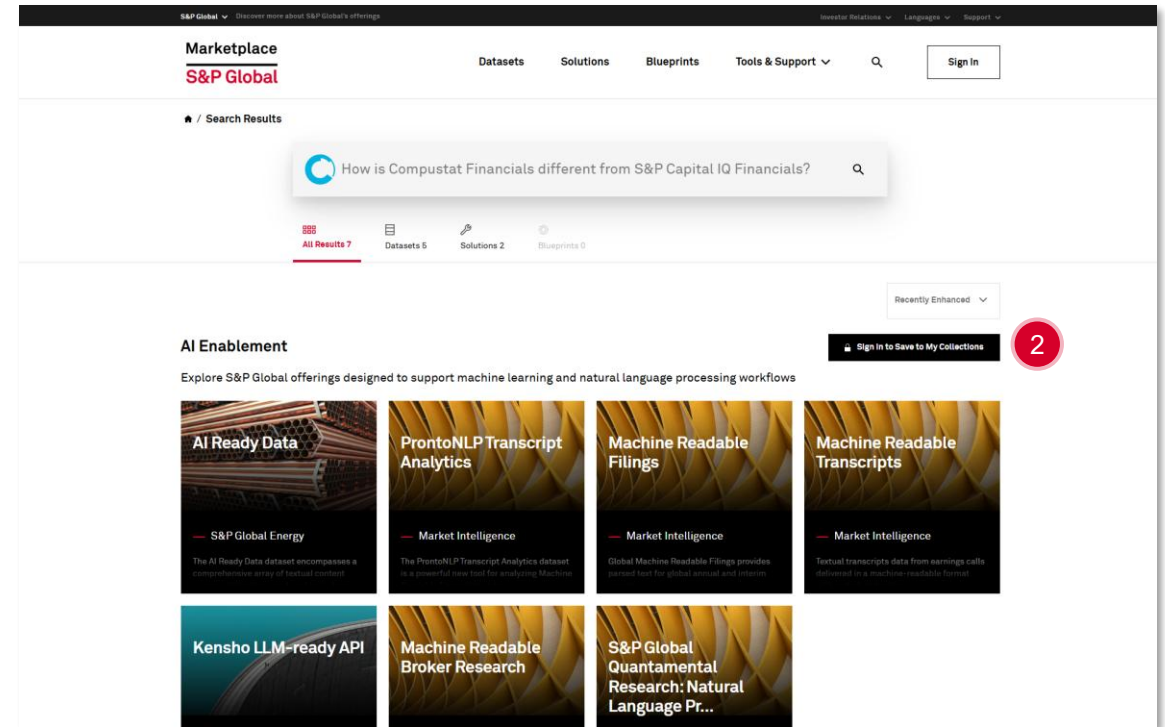


1 Logged-in users can use the Collections filter to view their Collections on the [Global Search Catalog page](#).

Sharing Collections

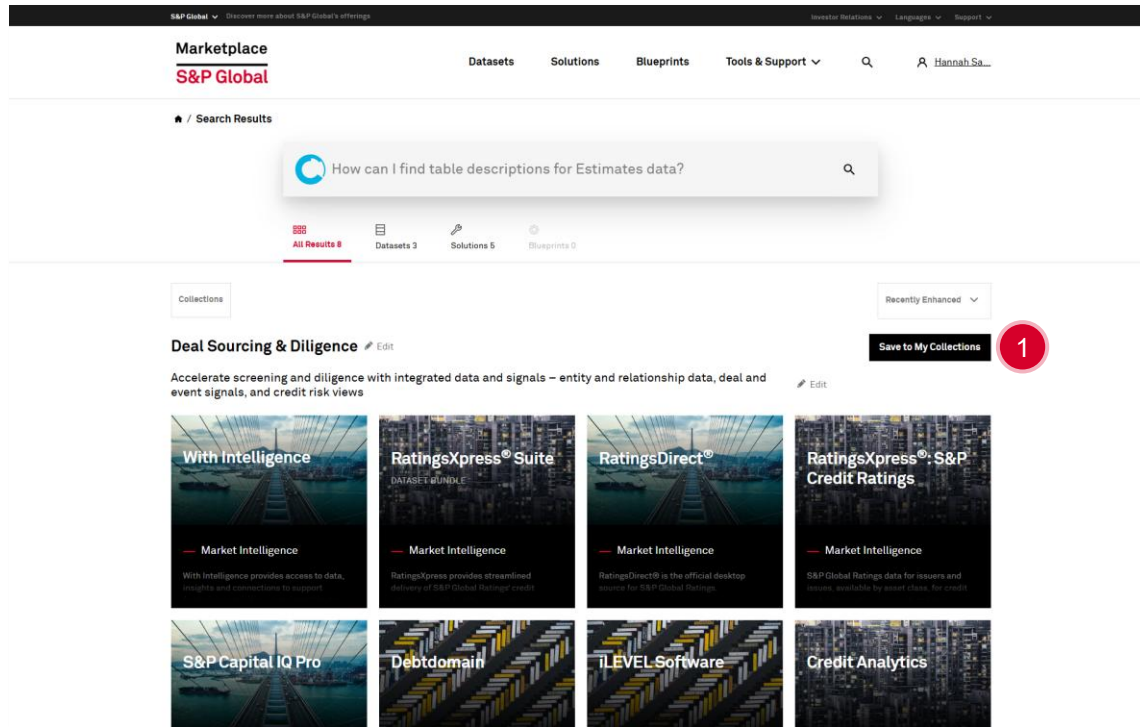


1 Collections can be shared with both logged-in and external audiences by selecting the 'Copy Shareable Link' button.

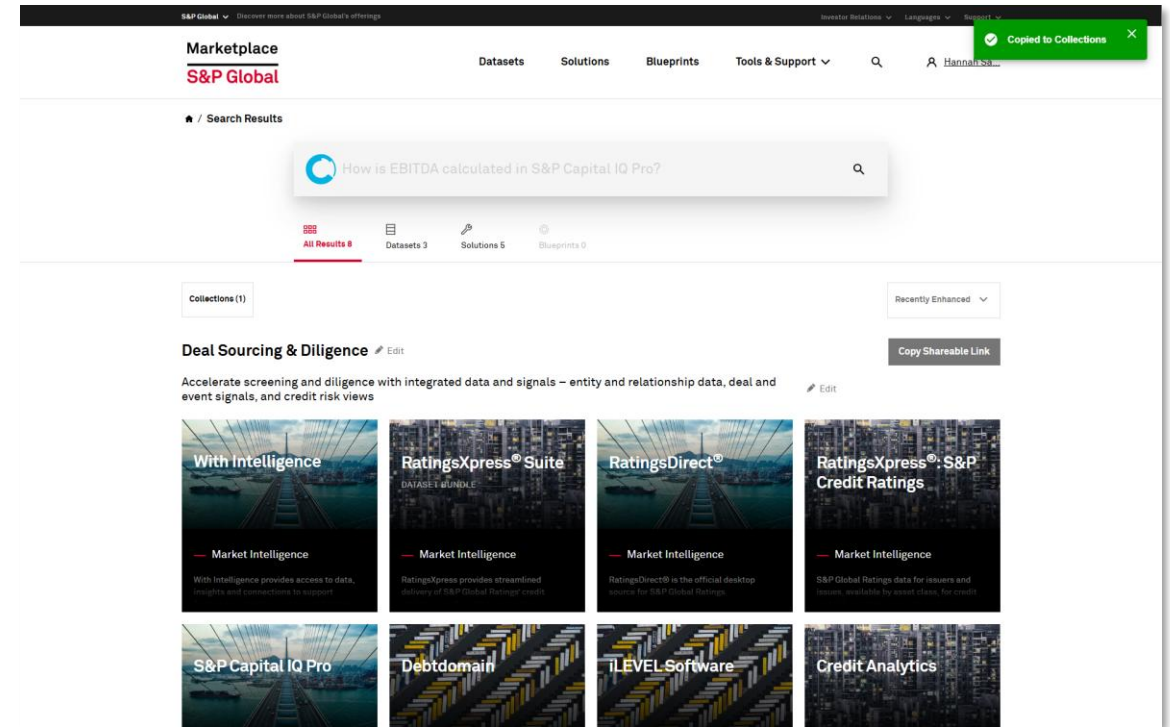


2 Recipients of shared Collections can view the Collection or select the 'Sign In to Save to My Collections' to copy a Collection into their own account.

Saving Shared Collections to My Account



1 Selecting the 'Save to My Collections' button will copy a shared Collection into a user's account.



2 Once the Collection is saved to a user's account, it can be customized without affecting the original and shared again with both logged-in and external audiences.
